A TRAINED leader is essential to providing a quality program. Units with trained leaders have better camping experiences, have better retention, and a better-quality program. To be considered fully TRAINED a SM must complete Scoutmaster Position Specific Training (PST), Youth Protection Training (YPT), and Introduction to Outdoor Leader Skills.

Scoutmasters, Assistant Scoutmasters, 2nd year Webelos Den Leaders, Venturing Crew Advisors and any registered leaders who will be camping with Scouts need to attend IOLS. Additionally, this course is required by Wood Badge for Scoutmasters and Assistant Scoutmasters.
