Aquatics activities require qualified adult (21+) supervision (Safe Swim Defense & Safety Afloat) and a BSA Lifeguard with current certification

Food service may be available for additional fees depending on availability. A SafeServ certified person must be present.

Overnight camping fees may be waived if the BSA unit contributes 4 hours of an approved service project at camp. This must be arranged with the ranger 10 business days in advance.
